MISSIONS HIGHLIGHT

SOUTHERN BAPTIST COOPERATIVE PROGRAM

Mountain View Baptist currently supports the Cooperative Program on a monthly basis through your generous tithes and offerings. What is Cooperative Program? It is Southern Baptists’ unified plan of giving through which cooperating Southern Baptist churches give a percentage of their undesignated receipts in support of the respective state convention and the Southern Baptist Convention missions and ministries. Each time you give, you become a participant in a worldwide missions enterprise. Sixty-three percent of our Cooperative Program stays in North Carolina Baptist Convention to support our five Baptist Universities in North Carolina and the Fruitland Baptist College. It supports our children’s home and senior adult homes, special needs homes, starting churches, strengthening churches and evangelism to reach over 5 million in North Carolina who are unbelievers. Thirty-seven percent is sent to the Southern Baptist Convention to support our six seminaries with 20,000 ministerial students, the International Mission Board with 4,800 missionaries overseas and the North American Mission Board with 5,000 missionaries in the USA and Canada. Cooperating, we can do more for the cause of Christ. By giving, you make a difference around the world.
